Eligible Entries

Open to any Afghan, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan, Pharaoh Hound, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound or CKC Miscellaneous Sighthound that is one year or older the day of the trial. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration, with the Canadian Kennel Club, have an ERN# or a PEN#. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, ASFA, CSFA OR AKC rules cannot compete. Hounds with breed standard disqualifications, or altered/neutered are eligible to enter the lure field trial. **Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada. See enclosed form.**

Directions To The Field

From the **North:**

Hwy #2 South to Balzac overpass. East on Hwy # 566 for about 22 km (14 miles) to Hwy #9. South on Hwy #9 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). East 1.6 km (1 mile) to Rge Rd 271. Right turn-South to first acreage. Use field entrance not private driveway.

From the **South:**

Deerfoot Trail (Hwy #2) North to Trans Canada Hwy (#1). East to Hwy #9. North 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). East 1.6 km (1 mile) to Rge Rd 271. Right turn-South to first acreage. Use field entrance not private driveway.

From the **East or West:**

Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #9. Follow directions from the South.

Alternate from **West to avoid Calgary:**

Hwy#22/22X through Calgary to Hwy 797. North on Hwy 797 through Langdon to Hwy #1. Cross Hwy #1 onto Hwy #9. Follow directions from the South.

Saturday and Sunday. Your dog is DQ'd or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Run individually, over the entire course (both directions) the dog is judged by two judges. No points are awarded and all ties are settled by a coin toss. A trophy and ribbon will be awarded to 1st place and ribbons for 2nd to NBQ. A special 25th Anniversary three day aggregate trophy will be awarded to the hound who accumulates the highest score running as a Single.

<u>Puppy Sweeps</u>	Puppies between 6 & 18 months are run individually. <i>Sat/Sun</i>
<u>Veteran Sweeps</u>	Dogs 7 years & older on date of trial. Run individually. <i>Sat/Sun</i>
<u>Breeder Stake</u>	Open to any 2 hounds in the official classes bred by the same person(s). <i>Sat. only</i>
<u>Kennel Stake</u>	Open to any 2 hounds in the official classes owned & kenneled by the same person(s). <i>Sun. only</i>

*NOTE: Breeder & kennel stakes combinations must be declared prior to Roll Call.

Placements and Awards

Chapter 7, Section 1: Championship points are awarded in regular stakes only on the following basis:

- 1st: 4 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 40 points
- 2nd: 3 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 30 points
- 3rd: 2 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 20 points
- 4th: 1 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 10 points
- NBQ: No points

No hound shall receive a placement or points if it does not score at least 50% of the total possible combined scores. If a hound has been **excused** in the preliminary run, that hound shall not count as having been in competition.

All prizes must be claimed at the trial. They will NOT be mailed.

Additional Information

- ☞ Overnight parking permitted on field. Access gate must be closed unless in use.
- ☞ Contact Field Trial Secretary for nearby Motels and Campgrounds.
- ☞ Stakes will be split if the entry is 24 or more hounds at roll call.
- ☞ Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless dismissed, excused or disqualified.
- ☞ Lame hounds or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- ☞ Hounds not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. **No Exceptions.**
- ☞ All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing a hound. A **Standing Start** will be used on Tally-Ho.
- ☞ Leg wrappings must be of a neutral colour to comply with CKC rules. Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion
- ☞ A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after Best in Field.
- ☞ **There will be a canteen for your eating pleasure.**
- ☞ Bring your own water and shade.
- ☞ No catalogue will be published. Score sheets will be available.
- ☞ A veterinary clinic is within easy access to the field.
- ☞ **Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down gopher holes.** Please bring a shovel to help fill gopher holes.

First Time Entered Hounds:

Effective July 1 1998, hounds entering their first trial in Canada must be tested with another hound, **not** a kennel mate, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. The CKC Hound Certification Form (included with this premium list) must be completed and **submitted with the entry at the hound's first trial**. Hounds with the following titles are exempt: ASFA F.Ch or LCM, AKC F. Ch., S.C. or D.C., but are still required to submit the Hound Certification Form with their name and exempt titles circled.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992 all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$58.85. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT TO AVOID CANCELLATION OF AWARDS.

Waiver of Requirement: This requirement will be waived for a hound that has earned a lure coursing title from another recognized organization if such title required competition, and if a waiver for such title has been approved by the Canadian Kennel Club. If your hound qualifies for a waiver, complete the top half of this form and attach it to your entry form.

All hounds must be a minimum of 12 months of age prior to being certified.
All hounds must run a normal course of 600 yards in order to be certified.
