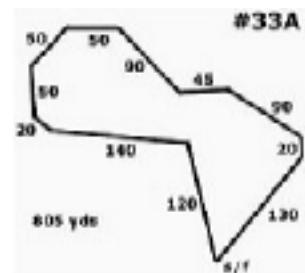
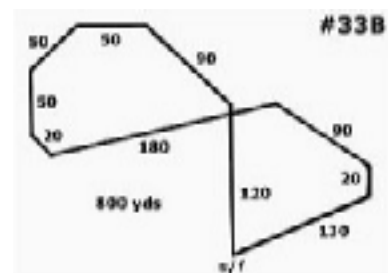

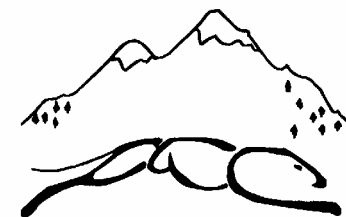

Additional Information

- ↪ Overnight parking permitted on field. **This is a working equestrian facility and canine training facility. Please respect man and beast.**
- ↪ Contact Field Trial Secretary for nearby Motels and Campgrounds.
- ↪ Stakes will be split if the entry is 24 or more hounds at roll call.
- ↪ Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless dismissed, excused or disqualified.
- ↪ Lame hounds or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- ↪ Hounds not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. **No Exceptions.**
- ↪ All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing a hound. A **Standing Start** will be used on Tally-Ho.
- ↪ Leg wrappings must be of a neutral colour to comply with CKC rules. Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion.
- ↪ A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after Best in Field.
- ↪ **There will be a canteen for your eating pleasure.**
- ↪ Bring your own water and shade.
- ↪ No catalogue will be published. Score sheets will be available.
- ↪ A veterinary clinic is within easy access to the field.

Eligible Entries

Open to any Afghan, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan, Pharaoh Hound, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound or CKC Miscellaneous Sighthound that is one year or older the day of the trial. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration, with the Canadian Kennel Club, have ERN # or PEN #. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, ASFA, CSFA OR AKC rules cannot compete. Hounds with breed standard disqualifications, or altered/neutered are eligible to enter the lure field trial. **Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada. See enclosed form.**

Approximate GPS Coordinates: N 51 13 37.1 W 114 05 36.6

From the North:

QE Hwy #2 South through Airdrie to Balzac Overpass. Exit west (right) on Hwy 566. Go West on Hwy 566 through Balzac to Range Road 14. Turn Right on Range Road 14 and go North to Wet Creek Stable and K9 Centre. Access to the field is just north of the arena. Signs will be posted.

From the South:

QE Hwy #2 North through Calgary to Balzac Overpass. If you enter Airdrie you've gone too far. Exit west (Left) on Hwy 566 and follow directions from North.

From the West:

Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #22 North at Cochrane. Follow Hwy #22 through Cochrane to Hwy #567 (Big Hill Springs Road). Turn right and go East on Big Hill Springs Road (you will cross Hwy 772) to Range Road 14. Turn right on Range Road 14 and go south to Wet Creek Stable and K9 Centre. Access to the field is just north of the arena. Signs will be posted.

From the East:

Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #9. Turn Right on Hwy #9 and go north to Hwy #566 where you turn left. Go West on Hwy 566 across the QE Hwy #2 (there is major overpass construction at this intersection so watch your speed!!) through Balzac and follow directions from North.

SINGLES COMPETITION

9:30 AM Roll Call. Your dog is DQ'd or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Run individually, over the entire course (both directions) the dog is judged by two judges. No points are awarded and all ties are settled by a coin toss. A trophy and ribbon will be awarded to 1st place and ribbons for 2nd to NBQ.

***NOTE:** Breeder & kennel stakes combinations must be declared prior to Roll Call.

Placements and Awards

Chapter 7, Section 1: Championship points are awarded in regular stakes only on the following basis:

- 1st: 4 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 40 points
- 2nd: 3 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 30 points
- 3rd: 2 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 20 points
- 4th: 1 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 10 points
- NBQ: No points

No hound shall receive a placement or points if it does not score at least 50% of the total possible combined scores. If a hound has been **excused** in the preliminary run, that hound shall not count as having been in competition. **Exhibitors please note:** As per rule 9.6.1(b) of the CKC Lure Field Trial Rules and Regulations a dog must "Attain 1 first or 2 second placements by **defeating dogs in head to head competition**". No placements will be awarded towards CKC championships if all dogs in a breed run as singles, but the points will stand.

All prizes must be claimed at the trial. They will NOT be mailed.

First Time Entered Hounds: (This does not apply to Singles Competition)

Effective July 1 1998, hounds entering their first trial in Canada must be tested with another hound, **not** a kennel mate, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. The CKC Hound Certification Form (included with this premium list) must be completed and **submitted with the entry at the hound's first trial**. Hounds with the following titles are exempt: ASFA F.Ch or LCM, AKC F. Ch., S.C. or D.C., but are still required to submit the Hound Certification Form with their name and exempt titles circled.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992 all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$58.85. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT TO AVOID CANCELLATION OF AWARDS.
